



2020 – 2021 School Supply List

Please purchase the corresponding supplies and bring with you before or on the first day of school. All personal supplies will be kept in a personal cubby. Please label personal supplies with your child's name. Community supplies do not need a name.

Personal Supplies – **Labeled with Name**

- Pencil box or bag
- 1 manual double-hole (standard and jumbo) covered pencil sharpener
- 1 box of 12 Premier Prisma colored pencils
- 8 ½" by 11" plain paper sketch book
- 1 cloth mask or face shield

New students only – **Labeled with Name**

- 3 Elmer's glue sticks (new students only)
- 1-inch three-ring binder (new students only)
- A box of sheet protectors (new students only)
- A set of 6 washcloths (new students only)
- A 6 in/cm wooden ruler (new students only)
- 1 two-pocket purple plastic folder (new students only)
- 1 pair of scissors (new students only)

Community Supplies – **NOT** Labeled with name



- 4 Mead PRIMARY Ruled Composition notebooks with 100 pages (Grade 1)



- 3 Mead WIDE Ruled Composition notebooks with 100 pages (Grades 2-6)
- 2 rolls of individually wrapped paper towels

Snack/Lunch Supplies

New students will need to bring their own ceramic plate, bowl, and mug. **Please write their name on the bottom with a permanent marker.** NO plastic or cartoon, movie, or TV characters please. They will be responsible for washing and caring for their items. These will be used for snack, lunch or birthday celebrations.



Lunch Box/Backpack

Lunch box and backpack need to be **labeled with the child's name on it**. No cartoon, movie or TV characters please.

Potted Indoor Plant

To give our classroom beauty and the children some responsibility, please send potted indoor plant with a saucer. One that could stand overwatering would be ideal! 😊 We will also use these in our botany lessons. Plants will be returned in June.

Change of Clothes

Please send a change of clothes in a plastic gallon Ziploc bag **labeled with your child's name** on it.

- Complete change of *school clothes* – shirt, pants, underwear, socks
- Jacket or sweater
- Names on clothing, lunchboxes, car seats, jackets, etc.

Suggested additional clothing that can be kept at school in their cubby:

- Rain gear, including rain boots
- A warm wool hat and gloves
- **We will be going outside on a daily basis, rain or shine!**

Indoor Shoes with Heel

- 2 pairs of plain-colored indoor slip-on shoes with traction and a heel strap, labeled with name. No soft fabric slippers with plastic soles—instead, an easy-to-clean, wipeable shoe. Examples of acceptable styles are Crocs, Native brand, Old Navy, or Keen.





Booster Seats

All children under the height of 4 feet 9 inches are required by law to use a booster seat for outings. Please label with your child's name. Some families purchase one to "live" at school.

Emergency Items

Please place the following items inside a Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name.

- 2 small, sealed bottles of water (8-12 oz.)
- 2 protein/power/granola bars
- 1 small package of moist wipes
- 1 small hand sanitizer
- 1 package of facial tissues in a travel-pack size (for example, Kleenex brand)
- 1 poncho (large garbage bag with 3 holes cut out – one for head and two for arms)
- 1 emergency blanket (available Fred Meyer or Target in the camping section)
- A small working flashlight which includes batteries

We will return any unused items at the end of the school year.
